The Desert Research Center, headed by Dr. Naim Moselhi, President of the Desert Research Center, in the presence of Dr. Abdullah Qassem Zaghloul, Vice-President of the Center for Projects and Supervisor of Research Stations, organized a visit by a delegation of students from New Mexico State University to inspect the activities of the Desert Research Center.

Dr. Fatima Ali Ahmed, Head of the Environment and Arid Land Agriculture Division at the Center, gave a presentation on the activities of the Desert Research Center in the presence of the research division heads and a number of young researchers at the center. The delegation was also accompanied by Dr. Ashraf .Noor, an assistant research professor at the Crop Production Unit in the Plant Production Department of the Environment and Dry Areas Agriculture Division.

Dr. Fatima Ahmed said that the student delegation made an inspection tour of the Library of the Desert Research Center and informed them of the original copy of the book describing Egypt, explaining that a visit was made to the Laboratory of Micro-Analysis at the Central Laboratory of the Center's research laboratories for plant analyzes and others using various chromatographic devices.

The Head of the Environment and Dry Areas Studies Division at the Desert Research Center explained that some of the laboratories of the Egyptian Center of Excellence for Desalination Research have been visited such as characterization lab, membrane performance lab, electronic scanning microscope lab, membrane manufacturing lab, and the central laboratory for water and soil analyzes was also visited.
